Things may look gloomy (and gloomier) but those of us who believe in European freedoms, benefits, togetherness and remaining or are upset or hurt by the referendum result are **not a fringe group!** We're at least half of the population. And what's more, many people who voted 'out' did so with a lack of information, false information, didn't really want 'out' to win or are otherwise unhappy with the outcome. **We can turn this around** – by **sharing good information, mythbusting and agitating**. We must not stand by and let UKxit happen.

Come and hear positive messages and plans for action, join the campaign and find out about small things you can do to help. This will include reflecting on why the UK voted 'out', how we can promote the truth, realities and the benefits of remaining together in positive ways (remember many people are campaign-worn and 'have heard it all before') and **space for your ideas and thinking**.

- **Citizenship and legal avenues**

Whilst we disagree strongly that non-UK, EU citizens should have to apply for anything to be able to stay in the UK and firmly hope the UK government will finally proclaim this, sadly this is a reality we have to face, so we're privileged to have an immigration lawyer speaking on the ins and outs of **applying for UK citizenship**. As previous weeks, we'll also look at **legal and constitutional issues** that may stand in government's way or be necessary/called for before **triggering article 50** – e.g. a parliamentary vote or ratification by the people of any final shape of UKxit hammered out. This could be a strand of campaigning and it's part of our ethos to **become knowledgeable** about important aspects in order to **argue and win our case**.
